#### **School Day Reminder**

As we start a new academic year here are a few reminders to help you, your children and us get back into the daily routine of school:

The gate opens at 8.35am and closes at 8.45am when teaching starts. Arrivals after 8.45am are marked as late. Any arrivals after 9am are marked as unauthorised. The school day ends at 3.15pm.

## **Topic Letters**

#### Trips

You will receive a letter next week about Key Stage 2 Cross Country and a trip to the Eden Project. The PTFA have kindly offered to subsidise the Eden Project trip so we can offer parents and families a reduced rate for entry, a coach and workshops at the Eden Project.

#### Uniform

A gentle reminder – Children should be wearing school uniform as per the list. If you cannot get uniform with a logo then plain colours that match the list will be okay. Thank you for your support with this.

### Our uniform is:

- Grey school trousers or shorts
- Grey skirt or pinafore dress
- Green checked summer dress or skirt
- Green school jumper or cardigan, plain or with logo
- White collared shirt or white/ dark green polo shirt
- Grey, black or white socks or grey/black tights
- Black school shoes (no brightly coloured trainers)

### PE

Plain green or black PE shorts or plain green or black jogging bottoms, white school PE t-shirt or plain white T shirt. Suitable footwear for sports— black, grey or white socks. School jumpers can be worn if cold. No jewellery - earrings must be removed or taped. Long hair must be tied back please.
